Subject: Certificate in Basic Expedition Leadership (BEL3)

3WW is to organise a BEL Course, which allows the Supervision of groups in Lowland Areas.

The Training dates are given on the attached sheet.

This will be based at Afan Forest Park and is open to any member of Staff/
Senior Cadet (ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE 18 BY THE COMPLETION OF THE
COURSE DATES), you should be aware that prior experience of backpacking and
campcraft is a Pre-Course entry requirement for all Candidates.

If you have completed any Expedition Section of the DoE Award (Bronze upwards), then
that should suffice to cover the minimum Pre-Course entry requirement.

The provisional cost is £150.00 per Candidate, to cover all Course costs apart from Travel,
Personal Kit purchases, and food.

The BEL ROA (Log Book) that Candidates and Course Tutors will complete is
£52.50, with the balance of the above charge going to offset campsite fees for the two
camping weekends, venue hire and handouts.

It is hoped that all uniformed Candidates will be able to claim pay, subject to them having
sufficient days, and that CI's can be reimbursed some travelling costs. It is
regretted that cadets are not allowed any form of re-imbusement. Candidates from
the same or near Squadrons will be encouraged to share transport wherever possible.

It is requirement of the BEL Certificate that all candidates attend every training day,
which will cover 100 hours training, followed by a minimum of 30 hours demonstration of
leadership. On completion of the 30 hours there will be an Assessed Camping Weekend.
